These activities are designed to give you some ideas of activities to do at home with your families or independently, to support your learning at school. Please choose **two** to complete this half term. Bring things in to share as and when you have done them. We can't wait to see your creativity!

Science – Seasonal Changes Autumn to Winter - Take some photos showing signs of autumn and winter - Find out about an animal that hibernates in the winter. - Make a rain gauge from a plastic bottle and see many cm of rain fall each week this half term	English - Instructions - Follow some recipe instructions to make something tasty for your family – photograph what you made to show us. - Play a game together following the instructions and rules carefully - Give someone instructions to follow to get to another room in the house	Maths - shape - Draw or photograph different shapes you see in and around your home. Can you find any shapes in nature? - Make a picture composed of lots of different shapes.	Art – Observational drawing - In Art we will be looking at the school and creating a piece in the style of Paul Klee's Castle and Sun - Draw your house or another building, looking closely at the detail on the building.
DT – Model Village - To go along with the geography theme of Our Local Area, choose a building in the village/town where you live and make a model out of junk materials. Can you decorate it to show all the details on the building? - You may want to take a photo of the building to work from so that you can use it to refer to.	Geography – Local area - Draw a map of your route to school, or to the park or the shop. What do you see on the way? - Imagine that you can sit on your bedroom ceiling like a fly and look down to the floor. Draw a map of what you would see. What would it look like from above?	PSHCE - Kindness - In PSHCE we have talked about kindness and how receiving a random acts of kindness can make people feel. - Talk with your grown-ups about a new task that you could commit to doing at home that would help out the household and be really appreciated. - Take a photograph to show us how you have been kind.	Future Me – Do you know your address? - In our geography we will talk about where we live. - In the future there will be many occasions where you need to tell someone exactly where you live. - Learn to say or write down your address.
