<b><u>History</u></b> <b>Values</b> (Curiosity, Responsibility & Respect) <b><u>Riotous Royals</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Which British monarch had the greatest impact on how we live our lives today?</li><li>• We will learn about William the Conqueror, King John, Henry VIII, Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria. We will learn about their reign and how the role of the monarch has changed over time.</li><li>• We will consider the legacy of each monarch.</li></ul>	<div></div> <div><b>Year 3</b> <b>Summer Term 2</b></div>	<b>Geography</b> <b>Values</b> (Curiosity, Responsibility and Respect) <b><u>Rainforests</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Look at different types of forests in the UK.</li><li>• Use atlases to locate rainforests around the world using the equator and tropics of cancer and Capricorn.</li><li>• Layers of the rainforest and the animals and plants that live in them.</li><li>• Consider why the rainforests need protecting and the impact of deforestation.</li></ul>
<b>Maths</b> <b>Values</b> (Resilience, Courage & Curiosity) <b><u>Geometry, Multiplication and Division &amp; Money</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Multiplication and Division – multiplying a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number. Dividing a number into equal groups and relating this back to our times tables. Understanding that sometimes when we divide numbers we have a remainder.</li><li>• A secure knowledge of Times Tables underpins all of this work. Please ensure children are accessing TT Rock Stars regularly throughout the week or using the flashcards they brought home.</li><li>• With Mrs Readings children will be learning how to covert pounds and pence and add / subtract amounts of money.
