- Compare it to the summer weather in the UK

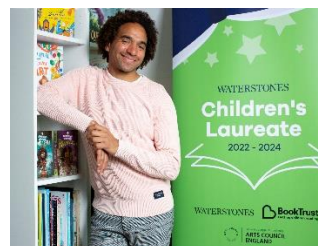


English

Rainforests

This half term in Geography we will be learning about Rainforests. Can you create your own 'rainforest in a box'?

Using a shoebox or something similar, create your own rainforest. Have a think about the different layers of the rainforest and what you might see in each layer.

To create the floor, you could collect some objects from nature including small stones, twigs and dried leaves and stick them in on the base of your box.
