### English

In English this half term, we will be writing **Recounts** based on our trip to Bletchley Park.

*A RECOUNT is a piece of writing that tells about something that has already happened, often from the writer's own personal experience*



Your task is to **CREATE YOUR OWN POSTCARD** based on something you did during the last school holiday [it can be any event – big or small! A swimming lesson? A shopping trip? A visit to the park?]

On one side, draw/make/find an image of the destination, and on the other side, write a short **RECOUNT detailing your experience...**

### Maths

This half-term, we will be studying **SYMMETRY...**

*Symmetry is when an object looks the exact same on one side as the other. To see if an object is symmetrical, you draw a line of symmetry or a line dividing an object to show a perfect match on each side. It's like making a mirror image.*

### Geography

This half-term, we will be studying **Northern Italy**

Italy is very famous for its delicious food!



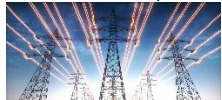
Your task is to **MAKE YOUR OWN GARLIC BREAD!**
