<p>History</p> <p>Civilisation Lapbook</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a fold-out lapbook about one civilisation. • Include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ A river map flap ◦ A farming diagram wheel ◦ An artefact pocket • Decorate using ancient-style patterns. 	<p>D&T / Music</p> <p>Junk Instrument Orchestra</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Build an instrument from junk materials. • Write instructions to play a short rhythm. • Perform it for someone at home. 	<p>Science – Rocks & Fossils</p> <p>Rock Museum in a Box</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decorate a shoebox as a mini museum. • Collect or draw at least 4 rocks. • Create labels showing texture, colour and guessed rock type. • Add a "Did you know?" fact flap inside the lid.
