<p>History</p> <p>Ancient Egyptians</p> <p>Find out about famous Pharaohs then create a series of 'Top Trump' style cards, which could include the following categories:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Years as a Pharaoh2. Power & Influence3. Achievements4. Popularity Now <p>Then, when you bring them into school you can play with your friends. Famous pharaohs include; Tutankhamun, Rameses II, Cleopatra VII, Akhenaten, Khufu and Hapshepsut.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>The Wild Robot</p> <p>Write a diary entry from the perspective of one of the animals on the island, when they first meet Ros.</p> <p>Remember to think about what happened and how the animal was feeling.</p> <p>Things to include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Past tense to describe what happened.• Present tense to describe feelings.• Time conjunctions to sequence the events.• First person – I and we.	<p>Science</p> <p>Plants</p> <p>All of the children will be given a sunflower seed to plant at home. Please plant this in a pot and use what we have learned about plants to look after your sunflower as it germinates and starts to grow.</p> <p>We will bring the sunflowers back to school after half term to compare how they have grown,</p>  <p>What conditions helped the sunflowers to grow?</p>
<p>Maths</p> <p>Fraction Hunt at Home</p> <p>Find 10 real-life fractions ($\frac{3}{4}$ full bottle, half a biscuit). Draw or photograph them and label the fraction. Can you put the fractions in order?</p> <p>Fraction Art</p> <p>Create a piece of abstract art at home that uses fractions of different shapes e.g. half of a circle, $\frac{1}{4}$ of a square etc..</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>Natural Sculpture / Art</p> <p>Can you create a piece of natural art or a natural sculpture using items collected from your garden or a local woodland. This about how you will assemble them? How can you join them in an environmentally friendly way?</p> <p>Photograph your creations to share with us.</p>	<p>Passport Activities</p> <p>In Year 3 we have completed many of our passport activities.
